Dear Parent / Guardian,

SATs - Last week, our Year 6 children undertook their SATs tests. I would like to thank the children for working so hard all year to ensure they were all in the best possible place to sit the tests. I think they all enjoyed the breakfast in the morning. I would like to thank all the staff for their help over the week and the other children in the school for working quietly during the tests.

This week, Year 2 have sat their end of year assessments in Reading and Maths. Whereas the Year 6 scores are completed solely on the tests themselves, year 2 also use teacher assessment to decide where the pupils are in line with national curriculum requirements.

Trips - Year 6 visited Paultons Park as their reward for working so hard all year and being so good for SATs week; Year 3 have been on a visit to Stonehenge as part of their topic and Reception class have visited the Cathedral as part of their topic work. All children enjoyed their trips. I would like to thank the volunteers who supported us on these outings.

Whole School Trip - On Friday 22nd June, we will be taking the whole school to Hengistbury Head. At the moment, as we are taking all staff and Governors, no additional volunteers are required. We will let parents know if we require anymore help nearer the date.

Parking - Please help us to ensure there is a good flow of traffic at the end of the school day by not parking on the road, especially on a Friday. As we go into the summer months, more and more traffic will start to come through the village as people will use it to bypass the traffic on Wilton Road. For some unknown reason, even though we worked hard to have the park and stride, in association with the cricket pitch, we still have many parents refusing to use this and instead block up the road. Parking on the yellow lines is endangering the lives of the children at the school.
